Ken Kenworthy stated he would like suggestions on how to correct the above audit findings. It was noted that the Council had changed some of the findings from the previous year. The Executive Director now balances the checking account with approval of Ken Kenworthy and also Cathleen Blair is an emergency signee of the checks if Ken Kenworthy, Melisa Jahner or Wendy Coker are not available to sign the checks for disbursement.
